How to Join a Zoom (Virtual) Meeting

When you receive a message from the Host for a Zoom meeting, click on the link to attend the meeting at the date and time stated in the message.

If you just want to watch and listen to the meeting without being seen or heard,

do not click the Join Video or Audio icons on your device.

That way no one can see or hear you.

If you wish to be seen and speak, then you need to initiate these controls by clicking them.

Either way the Host can see that you are attending the meeting.



A Little Bit of Heaven: Benefits of an Affiliate Library

For decades, serious genealogists have made the pilgrimage to Salt Lake City to delve into the rich resources of the Family History Library. As an alternative, man records could be viewed on microfilm sent to institutions across the country.

Many of the records housed at the Family History Library can now be viewed in digital format on home computers. Some records, however, can only be viewed at family history centers or affiliate libraries. These digital records include images and name indexes. Currently, there are about 400 million original records available in a digital format at affiliate libraries.

Now for the GOOD NEWS... we are an affiliate library! Your NVGS membership entitles you to access millions of records on our computers. Familysearch.org is better than ever at the library!
