Biography





Paper and Spit: Family Found: How DNA and Genealogy Revealed My First Parents' Identity

"I want you to know that you are adopted, and we can take you back anytime we want to." These are the first words that Don Anderson remembered hearing as a five year old in 1956. Despite the damage that those cruel and thoughtless words did to him he obtained a good education, had a successful marriage, and became a professional musician. In the year 2000, Oregon finally opened original birth certificates to adoptees and his search through the intricacies of DNA matches and genealogical research began. His memoir, Paper and Spit, chronicles his journey of self-discovery as he finds his family of origin. Every book I read on this topic is different and I always learn something new. This is one of the best and it even has a Napa connection.
